

Lasers & Your Skin


Long a cliché of science fiction movies, lasers have a storied history in Dermatology, having been used to treat everything from warts to skin cancer. LASER, or Light Amplification by Stimulated Emission of Radiation, uses light energy to target specific chromophores, or targets, in the skin. In some cases, a range of these wavelengths are used to treat multiple conditions at the same time using broad bands of light. Specific chromophores targeted in Dermatology are hemoglobin (in blood), melanin (in pigment), and water (in skin cells). Through a process called selective photothermolysis, these individual chromophores can be specifically targeted and modified. The providers at Aspire Dermatology will ensure both your safety and

The Vbeam Perfecta laser by Candela is considered the gold standard for treatment of increased vascularity, or redness. Using a 595 nm wavelength of light, this laser specifically targets hemoglobin in the blood, leading to destruction of small vessels that improves persistent redness. This workhorse can effectively treat conditions such as “cherry” angiomas, persistent flushing, dilated vessels, vascular birthmarks, and redder scars. Using ice packs and cold air, this treatment is well-tolerated and quick. Based on the condition being treated, there is a risk of bruising at the treatment site, but this resolves quickly and can be managed with supplemental pre-treatment and cosmetic cover-up. In most cases you can return to your normal activities immediately after the procedure.

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Browns got you down?

The **BroadBand Light (BBL) by Sciton** is one of the most powerful and effective intense pulsed light device available on the market today. BBL is interesting in that it can effectively target a number of chromophores using cut-off filters placed in front of an extremely bright light. The BBL's "claim to fame" is marked improvement in facial dyspigmentation secondary to sun exposure, such as "sun spots" or "age spots", while simultaneously treating the "redder" irregularities of the skin at the same time. Due to its tolerability and shorter recovery time, patients can often return to work the same day of treatment! Any discomfort can be effectively managed with a topical numbing cream applied a short time prior to the procedure.
